## Key 1 Aim High In Steering ©

$\Rightarrow$ An animal's eyesight is suited to its survival needs
$\Rightarrow$ Average drivers have 3-6 seconds of Eye Lead Time
$\Rightarrow$ Expand your Eye Lead to a minimum of 15 seconds

## REMIEMBER THE 5 KEYS

## Key 1 AIM HIGH IN STEERING ${ }_{\circledast}$

$\Rightarrow$ Look ahead a minimum of 15 seconds
Key 2 GET THE BIG PICTURE ${ }_{\oplus}$
$\Rightarrow 4$-second minimum following distance
$\Rightarrow$ Scan mirrors every 5-8 seconds
Key 3 KEEP YOUR EYES MOVING $\oplus_{\odot}$
$\Rightarrow$ Avoid focusing on one object for more than 2 seconds
Key 4 LEAVE YOURSELF AN OUT ${ }_{\oplus}$

# WHYY DO BACKING COLLISIONS HAPPPEN? 

$\Rightarrow$ Backing Unnecessarily
$\Rightarrow$ Blind Areas
$\Rightarrow$ Vehicle Design
$\Rightarrow$ Infrequent Practice
$\Rightarrow$ Limited Mental Preparation For Backing
$\Rightarrow$ Inadequate Information During Backing

# Key 3 Keep Your Eyes Moving © 

$\Rightarrow$ Scan the entire area
$\Rightarrow$ Don't forget the front and the sides
$\Rightarrow$ Back slowly



# When possible, avoid backing! If you must back... 

Key 1 AIM HIGH IN STEERING ${ }_{\oplus}$
$\Rightarrow$ Choose the safest location possible
Key 2 GET THE BIG PICTURE ${ }_{\text {® }}$
$\Rightarrow$ Search for all potential hazards
Key 3 KEEP YOUR EYES MOVING ${ }_{\oplus}$
$\Rightarrow$ Scan, don't fixate
Key 4 LEAVE YOURSELF AN OUT ${ }_{\circledast}$
$\Rightarrow$ Surround yourself with space
Key 5 MAKE SURE THEY SEE YOU ${ }_{\circledast}$
$\Rightarrow$ Use warning devices - Make eye contact


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
