Pump Motor Will Not Start		
 Verify electrical switches are in proper position and power is reaching the starter 	9	
2. Verify fuel level and type in pump fuel tank	8	
3. Determine that the fuel pump and/or primer is functioning	8	
4. Cycle the choke to ensure proper function	8	
5. Remove the spark plugs and check for fouling and proper gap	8	
Pump Motor Starts, but Will Not Remain Running		
Verify the position of any override switches	8	
Check valve configuration; tank-to-pump is open and discharges are closed	8	
3. Verify fuel is reaching the motor; fuel filter, fuel level	9	
4. Verify proper air/fuel mix; choke disengaged, air filter clear	9	
Pump Motor Starts, but Water Pressure Fails to Build		
 Check valve configuration; tank-to-pump open, discharges are closed, tank fill is closed 	9	
2. Check strainer for blockage	8	
3. Verify the pressure gauge is functioning	8
