2. Operational Period:

3. Safety Plan/Message:**Hazards:**

- Slips. Trips and Falls.
- Strenuous Activities: ladder placement
- Operating at height on a walkable roof surface
- Contact with blunt objects.
- Operating at heights (ladders)
- Use of gas / battery saws

Mitigations:

- Trip and/or fall hazards will be closely monitored by BC702 and the site facilitator.
- Crews will be required to wear full PPE to include hand, ear and eye protection
- Crews will be monitored for over exertion.
- Personnel will be encouraged to call out any unsafe acts or situations.
- Healing and/or securing of all ladders.

Safety Message

Everyone is responsible for safety - Stop and correct an unsafe act immediately!!!

Rest work cycles: Monitored by BC702 or the company officer

Weather: TBD based on weather report the day of training. We will adapt weather dependent.

Appropriate PPE:

- Full structural firefighting PPE utilized
- Work gloves, helmet, eye and ear protection utilized as needed

Emergency Communications Plan:

BC702 will be responsible for making any radio transmissions, or communications, in the event of a real incident or injury. EMS would be requested via 7A1 if needed. Communication to the DOC and safety officer would be via cell

Crews will be advised to use the words “real incident” should they need to communicate a real issue during training.

Safety Plan Narrative:

The training will be as “life like” as possible and therefore all personnel will be required to utilize their issued PPE. As stated above, BC702 and the site facilitator will closely monitor safety issues and ensure compliance of all safety measures to avoid any potential issues or injury.
