Subject: Serving as Election Judges

The Montgomery County Board of Elections conducts elections that allow our registered voters to choose their elected representatives in local, State, and/or Federal government.

The 2024 Presidential General Election is fast approaching on Tuesday, November 5.

Successful administration of elections requires a large number of employees and volunteers. Therefore, we are asking our County employees to serve as Election Judges on Election Day (Tuesday, November 5) for the 2024 Presidential General Election.

The Board especially needs individuals with bilingual language skills and recruits for a balance of political party affiliations at each polling place.

To serve as an Election Judge, you must be a United States Citizen, a registered voter in Maryland, and you must pass an online quiz and attend an in-person training.

A full day of service provides a minimum stipend of \$250 per day and \$50 for in-person training. Election Judges who previously served (before the 2024 election cycle) as an election judge at the polling place during early voting or on election day, will receive a \$100 bonus for each full day of service or a \$50 bonus for each half day served during early voting and/or on election day.

County employees are encouraged to serve as election judges. **Employees must receive supervisory approval prior to serving.** Employees serving on Election Day, Tuesday, November 5, 2024, are eligible for administrative leave of up to a maximum of 8 hours. Timecards should be recorded with the pay code – *Admin Leave - Other* and the reason code – *ELECTION*.
