



- ➤ Please keep the MF Plaza full of events as much as possible. A farmer's market would be great. Could be on a weekday afternoon to catch worker and residents. PLEASE push for the lighted sign on Georgia that was supposed to be there to alert people passing by to what's happening in Wheaton.
- ➤ Keep the Friday night concerts going. Add other genres of bands. Bring in, say a salsa or bachata teacher, or swing, or hip hop, when appropriate.
- ➤ Where is parking for people who cannot walk or stand very long? This "Walkable" stuff leaves out a lot of us!
- > Extend TGIF to the weekend
- Advertise Events more. Make them accessible for people who cannot walk a long ways, (a block) or stand for long (10 mins.) Include things the American community might like. I enjoyed the bands that used to play on Reedie where the new building was built, and I could listen in my car.

- ➤ I have lived in Wheaton for over 10 years, but I am not sure how to find out about these events. I would love to get more involved with the Wheaton community, especially for my kids, but I am not sure where to start.
- ➤ I think some events go on too long. 11 am 5 pm or thereabouts is a long time for a local business or organization to commit to on a weekend. Events with food would work best during lunch or dinner times, but fizzle out in mid- to late afternoon. Wheaton Arts Parade and Taste of Wheaton come to mind. Wheaton Arts Parade should not start so early on a Sunday, as many people sleep in or go to church. Should start at noon or 1 pm or early on a Saturday morning.
- > We are generally pleased with these events. We hope that they continue and can expand into utilizing the new county building in Wheaton Triangle.
- > Entertainment choices do not appeal to seniors. Great for young people; not so much for us older residents.
- An electronic billboard on GA. Ave that is regularly updated would be a great help in advertising events at Fryer Plaza and bringing more people to events there.

- These events are a great experience and time. The more we can have them be benchmark experiences in the community with different organizations involved, the better they will be and the more they will feed on themselves. It would also be great to know what the attendance of these events were in future meetings.
- > I think there should be more advertising for such events because I didn't know about them.



- > Include safety and non-violence during daytime hours for all attendees.




How do you hear about events happening in the Wheaton Urban District? Check all that apply.





- Coordinate with other area events to avoid conflict of attendance
- ➤ Get the retail space in the County Building filled with a good restaurant with a cultural element (such as Bus Boys); Get the Arts and Culture Center built!
- ➤ I'd love for there to me a Wheaton resident market once a month to help support those of us in the community with businesses and products we can sell.
- > Include safety for everyone attending.
- ➤ This may not fall under WUD but I love the Arts Parade and having the triangles and art bomb squares up all year!

- ➤ Need more parking that does not impinge on local restaurants & businesses, so we older people can participate.
- The further from Wheaton (ie Aspen Hill/Olney) you get the less Wheaton info seems available/ part of the community
- ➤ One year Wheaton held an Irish/Scottish "Bar Crawl" when the two bars were close to each other that included music and dance. So festivals of all kinds like Irish, Central American, Ethiopian, Nigerian, Caribbean, Greek or Mediterranean—there are so many cultures living and working in Wheaton. I like how TGIF highlights different music types and cultures.







TGIF 2024 - DEMOGRAPHICS




