

What are the Urban Districts?

- Montgomery County has four Urban Districts: Bethesda, Friendship Heights, Silver Spring, and Wheaton
- Bethesda/Silver Spring/Wheaton UDs created in 1986 to maintain & enhance these urban centers
- Bethesda, Silver Spring, and Wheaton Urban Districts provide:
 - Streetscape, sidewalk, & tree maintenance
 - Cleanliness (e.g. trash removal) & security
 - Public amenities (plantings, seating, shelters, art)
 - Promotion of commercial & residential interests
 - Placemaking, cultural, and community activities



Wheaton Urban District Stats

201.6 acres

24 personnel, including 10 Clean Team & 10 Safe Team members

Administered by Mid-County Regional Services Center, advised by Wheaton Urban District Advisory Committee (WUDAC)




Funding Sources

Urban Districts receive revenue from a variety of sources, primarily:

- Urban District property tax (3 cents per \$100 in Wheaton)
- Parking Lot District revenue transfer
- County general fund

What is a Main Street?

- Local programs designed to strengthen the economic potential of main streets and neighborhoods
- Promote economic vitality, design, promotion, organization, cleanliness, and safety
- Less focused on heavy maintenance and operations than Urban Districts
- Maryland has 34 communities designated as Main Streets, including Takoma Park
- Umbrella organizations: Main Street America and Main Street Maryland
