




6 STEPS TO PREPARE FOR MONTGOMERY COUNTY GRANTS

Interested in applying for Montgomery County Government grants? Follow these steps to ensure your organization is prepared and stays informed about grant opportunities.

- 1. Visit the Office of Grant Management (OGM) Website (<https://montgomerycountymd.gov/ogm>)**
This website is your central hub for County grant information. Review current funding opportunities, access grant resources, find important announcements, and sign up for OGM’s weekly Newsletter.
- 2. Create a Profile in the Euna Grants (eCivis) Platform (<https://portal.ecivis.com/#/login>)**
OGM uses the Euna Grants (eCivis) platform to collect applications and manage awards for most County grant programs. Create and maintain an organizational profile, add team members, and ensure your information is accurate for future grant opportunities and application submissions.
- 3. Subscribe to the OGM Newsletter (<https://montgomerycountymd.gov/ogm>)**
Receive updates about new grant programs, training sessions, and important announcements. To subscribe, visit the OGM website, scroll to the middle of the page, click “Subscribe to The Montgomery County Grant Opportunities Newsletter,” enter your email address, and select "Submit."



- 4. Maintain Good Standing with the Maryland State Department of Assessments and Taxation (SDAT) (<https://egov.maryland.gov/businessexpress>)**
Your organization must be registered and in **Good Standing** with SDAT to receive grant funds. Confirm your status and resolve any outstanding compliance issues before applying. OGM will verify this status during the application review process.
- 5. Register with the County’s Vendor Registration Systems (CVRS) (<https://azex32.montgomerycountymd.gov/cvrs>)**
To receive grant payments, your organization must be registered in CVRS. Ensure your registration is current and enroll in ACH (direct deposit) to receive funds more quickly.
- 6. Maintain Current or Exempt registration status with the Maryland Secretary of State OneStop – Charities Public Registry (https://onestop.md.gov/list_views/62f3e1797f7e3200016a3dab)**
Applicable organizations must have a Registration Status of “Current” (or “Exempt”) the Maryland Secretary of State OneStop – Charities Public Registry to be eligible for County grant funding. OGM will verify this status during the application review and awarding process.
