

Police Accountability Board of Montgomery County, MD

December 2025 Complaint Report

Complaints entered into the Portal: **5**

- **3** were defined as Eligible by the Montgomery County Department of Police.
- **1** was defined as Eligible by the Rockville City Police Department.
- **1** was defined as Ineligible by the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office.

Complaints received through other methods*: **16**

- **1** was defined as Eligible by the Montgomery County Sheriff's Office and is currently Under Investigation.
- **12** were received by the Montgomery County Department of Police. 11 are Eligible and Under Investigation, and 1 is Ineligible.
- **1** was received by the Maryland National Capital Park Police and is Eligible and Under Investigation and are within State ACC Jurisdiction; therefore, no additional information can be reviewed at a local level.
- **2** were received by the Rockville City Police Department and are Eligible and Under Investigation.

*Other methods are defined as:

- PAB Staff
 - By Phone to the Office of the County Executive or PAB staff
 - By Email to the County Executive or other local, state governing agencies
 - In Person or Hand Delivered to the Office of the County Executive or PAB Staff
 - Mailed to the Office of the County Executive or PAB staff
- Law Enforcement Agency
 - By Phone to the Agency
 - By Email to the Agency
 - In Person to Agency
 - Mailed to the Agency
 - Online to Agency (outside of the PAB Complaint Portal)
 - Other Method previously established by the Agency

*What makes a complaint Eligible:

- The incident must have occurred after 7/1/22, the Establishment of the legislation
- The incident must involve a member of the public and actions of a member of Law Enforcement
- The incident must involve a member of law enforcement who is not currently under a collective bargaining agreement. Those under collective bargaining agreements still fall under the Law Enforcement Officers Bill of Rights until 7/1/2023

- Each month, Montgomery County Law Enforcement Agencies* report to the ACC (through ACC Staff) any complaints they received (through the portal or other methods) and the status of the investigation, for any eligible complaints
