WHAT IS THE MONTGOMERY COUNTY POLICE FOUNDATION?

The Police Foundation is a business-sponsored private organization dedicated to improving the quality of police service in Montgomery County and strengthening the relationship between the police and the community.

Founded in 1995, the Police Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, with both business and individual members.

The Foundation receives and distributes dues and contributions on behalf of the public good, specifically as "seed" money for start-up programs or to support other initiatives seen as necessary by the Department of Police when County funding is not available. The Foundation also facilitates the donations by businesses of services, facilities, equipment, and other resources on an as-needed basis.

WHAT IS THE COUNTY GOVERNMENT'S ROLE WITH THE FOUNDATION?

The Montgomery County government has approved the formation of the Foundation and the County Executive has expressed his appreciation for the Foundation's work.

Montgomery County government and Police Department employees are not members of the Foundation and have no official role with the Foundation.

However, The Foundation looks to Chief of Police Marcus G. Jones and his senior staff for guidance as to what activities and expenditures would best benefit the Police Department.

WHAT DOES THE POLICE FOUNDATION DO?

The Police Foundation facilitates the exchange of management and technical expertise between the business members of the community and the Montgomery County Department of Police.

The Foundation also provides resources in support of the development of selected Montgomery County Department of Police public safety projects.

The Foundation enhances the community's awareness of the contributions toward public safety made by the Montgomery County Department of Police.

WHAT DOES THE POLICE FOUNDATION NOT DO?

The Police Foundation does not support any political candidate or agenda and it does not provide continuous funding of programs that are more appropriately supported by the County budget.

HOW HAS THE POLICE FOUNDATION HELPED THE POLICE DEPARTMENT?

The Montgomery County Police Foundation has provided more than \$1 million to the Montgomery County Police Department.

These funds have been used for a broad range of support for the Police Department, ranging from the purchase of bicycles and equipment for the County's highly effective bicycle patrol program to the purchase of much-needed computer equipment to the provision of specialized personnel development classes for many police department employees.
