#### Strathmore Local Park Ribbbon Cutting

- Montgomery Parks celebrated reopening the recently renovated Strathmore Local Park in Aspen Hill. More than one hundred residents gathered at the park on Saturday, October 19, 2024, as we cut the ribbon, officially opening the renovated park.
- Strathmore Local Park is located at 3210 Beaverwood Lane in Aspen Hill. The renovation includes an improved soccer field, a basketball and soccer court, and a new playground with play structures for children ages 2-12. There is also a loop walking path, a picnic pavilion with tables, benches, and barbecue grills.
- The park renovation was funded by Montgomery Parks, Program Open Space, and a bond bill passed by the Maryland General Assembly.

### Montgomery Parks Pope Farm 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

- Montgomery Parks celebrated the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Pope Farm Nursery. Brian Dahl, the facility manager, shared insights into the nursery's history and its remarkable journey since the Commission acquired it from the Pope Farm in 1968. The nursery has been operational since 1974, making this significant milestone.

#### NPDES Permit

On October 17, 2024, staff presented their progress in meeting goals established by the Maryland Department of the Environment (MDE) for the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit. This initiative includes a focus on reducing stormwater pollution and enhancing water quality. The permit submission represents a significant, cross-divisional collaborative effort that pulls in teams from almost every division across the entire department. This year marks the

#### Carolyn Freeland Urban Park reopens

- Montgomery Parks reopened Caroline Freeland Urban Park in downtown Bethesda on Saturday, November 9, 2024, following an extensive renovation. Montgomery Parks Director Miti Figueredo and Montgomery Planning Board Chair Artie Harris were joined by special guests Maryland State Delegates (D-16) Marc Korman and Sarah Wolek, Montgomery County Council President Andrew Friedson, and Megan Raymond, granddaughter of Caroline Freeland.
- Families and community members joined the celebration, enjoying games, refreshments, and activities. The \$3.3 million renovation introduced a spacious central lawn, a large seating terrace, and accessible pathways that connect to a larger playground, relaxing bench swings, and bike parking. The new entry plaza on Hampden Lane welcomes pedestrians and provides emergency vehicle access when needed.
- A panel commemorating Caroline Freeland's accomplishments will be installed in the park later this year.

New pickleball courts open at East Norbeck Local Park

Montgomery Parks is expanding pickleball opportunities by adding six dedicated courts at East Norbeck Local Park. A ribbon-cutting celebration took place on Wednesday, November 13, 2024, from 6 to 8 p.m. to highlight the new courts and welcome nighttime play under the lights.



#### Montgomery Parks' Urban Wood Sale

Montgomery Parks held its annual Urban Wood Sale on the weekend of November 9-10, 2024, at the Green Farm Maintenance Facility. The wood sold at this event came from dead or dying trees that were removed from Montgomery Parks land. Each year, park arborists cull hundreds of trees as part of a program aimed at promoting a healthy tree canopy. Some of the downed trees are suitable for the wood sale, while others are recycled into wood chips, mulch, and firewood through the Montgomery Parks Green Waste Recycling Program.



The wood species sold included walnut, cherry, poplar, oak, mulberry, cypress, and ash. The wood is kiln-dried, planed, and air-dried. Slabs were available in different lengths and thicknesses, ranging from three-quarters of an inch to three inches.
