Kathy Green is stepping down as MCPS Liaison. She introduced Bryan Walker who will be transitioning onto the Committee.

Kathy discussed MCPS's Flag Football initiative, beginning as a varsity sport this fall, the growth of the sport, and that it will be the fastest growing sport in HS sports, especially for girls. This year MCPS is also starting pickleball as a varsity sport at all high schools this fall.

Tom stated that in the next few years deciding which sports to invest in and for what reasons will be major questions to answer.

Jason reported that Nancy Petzold-Earp from CUPF has resigned from her position as exoficio from CUPF. It is unclear who her replacement will be.

Darren Flusche raised a concern that because so many fields are permitted there is a lack of opportunity for walk-on play on ballfields. Parks will hold three open play sessions:

September 28 at Blair HS; October at MLK Park and November at Laytonia Park. Tom asked Darren to provide updates at future meetings.

Tina shared that she is waiting to hear the status of the CUPF fee study.
