6:13 pm - Sports Programming Directory Options

See handout from Jason's email earlier this week.

This discussion of options for implementing a sports programming directory included the following topics

- Logistical challenges of delivering a web-based tool, given the increasing complexities of managing county-hosted websites. restrictions on county website
- Growing role of Al
- Alternatively, prioritize capacity building by creating a network of sports organizers, the site for which could be hosted on a non-county server. Focus on smaller orgs that would benefit more from collaboration, as well as other area rec departments. Example: Philadelphia Youth Sports Collaborative. Offer trainings and possibly funding.
- Annual printed directory that allows for full vetting of sports providers and could be linked from county sites.

Summary: The committee still sees value in and energy behind some sort of program directory but also there is new, significant energy for a tool to support providers as well as consumers.

ACTION: Investigate Arts & Humanities Council / other county entities

that maintain independent websites.

ACTION: Everyone should think about this issue for next meeting.

- What are appropriate goals for middle school sports (preparation for high school athletics versus other goals) what is the intrinsic value of middle school sports?
- Intramural data not shared with MCPS athletics dept because it's considered more general programming
- Facilities continue to be a huge barrier
 - Most middle schools only have one gym
- Also transportation (activity buses after practices/games; transportation to schools for games)
- And scheduling: activity buses only run 3x/week because Monday afternoon is teacher work time.
