 - i. Priorities include crime in DTSS. Discussion with community members focused on hookah bars, late-night businesses.

 - a. D3 leads MoCo police department in illegal gun seizures.
 - b. Traffic enforcement initiative at DC/SS border, along Eastern Ave and Georgia Ave
 - c. Drone first-responder program announcement it responded to a call about theft from Safeway. Drone arrived within minutes. Pilot was able to see the suspects and direct officers to them without disrupting the neighborhood. They were stealing diapers and food. Another example of a 911 call about a person with a gun drone investigated along with officers on the way; that the drone cam could tell wasn't real, so officers did not have to get involved.
